

Beach Bag



Materials

- 0.8m fabric 140cm wide
- 1.5m lining
- 0.6m vinyl
- 4 O-rings 38mm
- 1.5m trim for handles
- sewing machine, thread, scissors, and iron
- optional: 1 magnetic clip, 1 8" invisible zipper



Instructions

1. Cut a rectangle **44"x23"** out of fabric and **40"x23"** of lining.



2. Cut out bag bottom, referencing the diagram on the next page. Cut 1 of vinyl and 1 of lining.



3. Sew a rolled hem on the long edges of the bag bottom vinyl (23" sides).



4. Centre the leather bottom piece face up on the right side of the fabric and sew into place.



5. Cut the fabric on both sides where the leather bottom is cut out.



6. Fold fabric good to good and stitch sides. Press seams open.



7. Bring the side seam to the middle of the cut-out and stitch. Repeat on other side.

8. Repeat steps 3 - 7 with the lining. *Optional: add zipper pocket to lining*



9. Cut 4 strips of vinyl 1"x6". Thread through o-rings and baste vinyl on top edge of bag.




10. Press top edge of fabric under 2". *Optional: attach magnetic snaps to the top of the bag on 2" fold*



11. Place bag and lining good sides together making sure vinyl tabs are tucked in. Stitch top edge with 1/2" seam allowance, leaving an opening to turn inside out.



12. Turn inside out and slip stitch opening closed. Top stitch edge of bag.



13. Thread in the belting trim through the o-rings to create the purse straps and sew.
