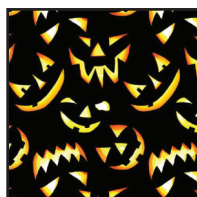

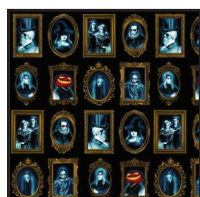

Fabric F	Graveyard	0.6m

Backing Fabric

Wide Width Cotton 1.4m

Please read instructions carefully before cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge unless otherwise noted.

From Fabric A & F cut:

(6) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

From Fabric B cut:

(2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

From Fabric C cut:

(3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

From Fabric D cut:

(4) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

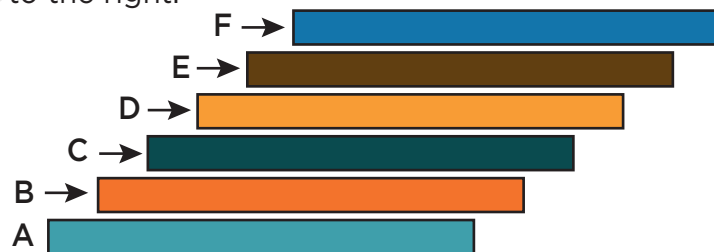
From Fabric E cut:

(5) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

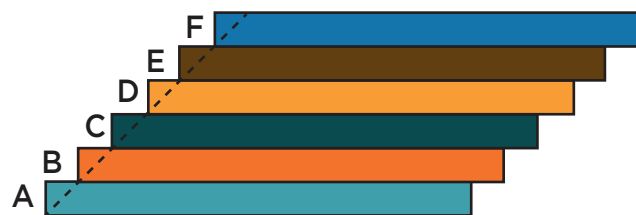
Block Assembly

Block 1

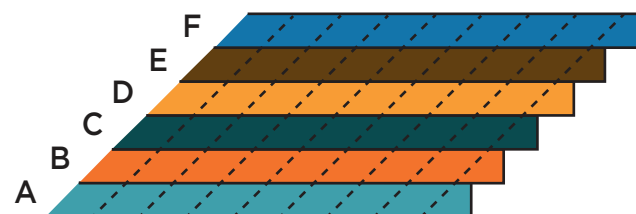
Sew (1) A, (1) B, (1) C, (1) D, (1) E & (1) F together, Offsetting the ends by $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to the right.



Trim your offset edge at a 45° angle



Subcut (8) strips, $4\frac{3}{4}$ " apart, at a 45° angle



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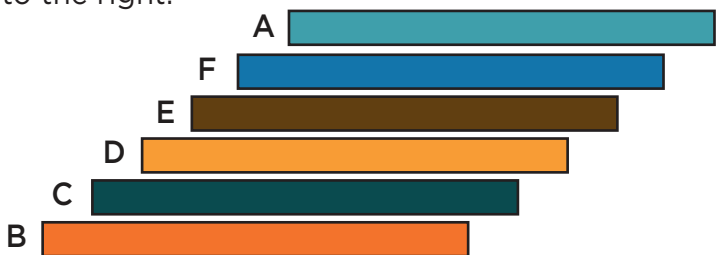
The Haunted Circle

This will give you (8) of Block 1



Block 2

Sew (1) B, (1) C, (1) D, (1) E, (1) F & (1) A together, Offsetting the ends by $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to the right.

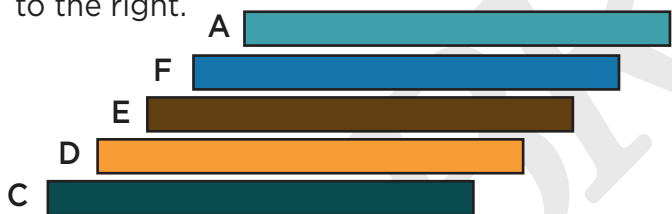


Repeat the previous steps until you have (8) of Block 2



Block 3

Sew (1) C, (1) D, (1) E, (1) F & (1) A together, Offsetting the ends by $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to the right.

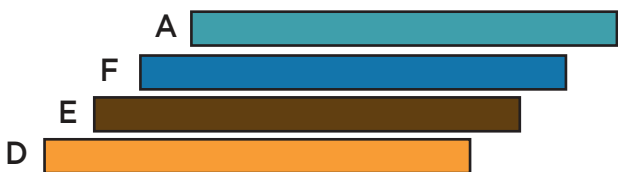


Repeat the previous steps until you have (8) of Block 3



Block 4

Sew (1) D, (1) E, (1) F & (1) A together, Offsetting the ends by $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to the right.



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Repeat the previous steps until you have (8) of Block 4



Block 5

Sew (1) E, (1) F & (1) A together, Offsetting the ends by $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to the right.



Repeat the previous steps until you have (8) of Block 5



Block 6

Sew (1) F & (1) A together, Offsetting the ends by $3\frac{1}{2}$ " to the right.

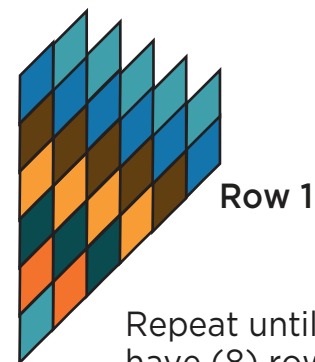
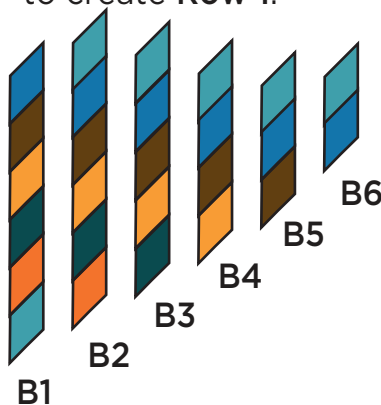


Repeat the previous steps until you have (8) of Block 6



Row Assembly

Sew (1) Block 1, (1) Block 2, (1) Block 3, (1) Block 4, (1) Block 5, & (1) Block 6 together to create Row 1.



Repeat until you have (8) rows.

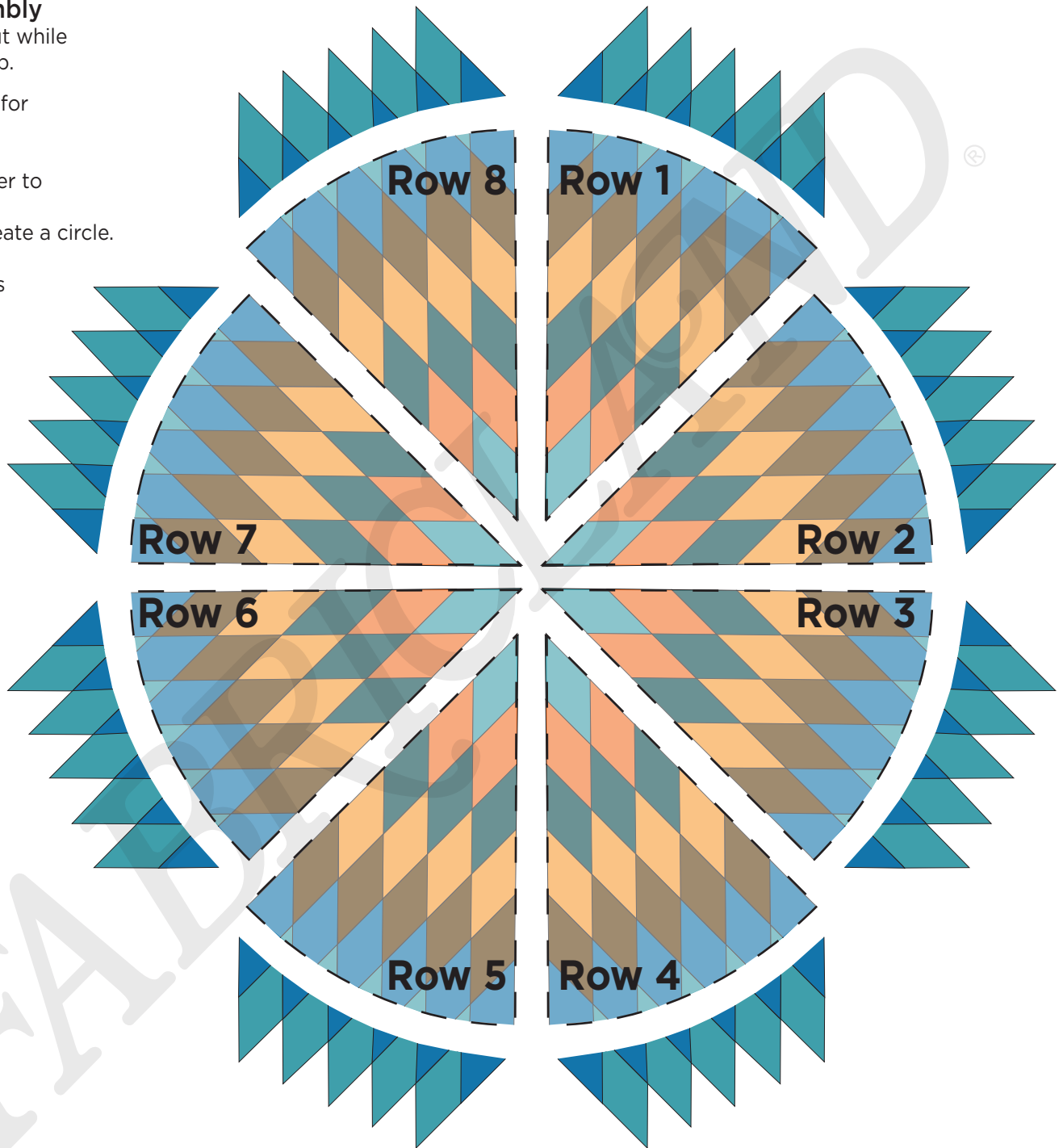
The Haunted Circle

Quilt Layout

Quilt Top Assembly

*Follow Quilt Layout while assembling quilt top.

- Use Quilt Layout for Row location.
- Sew rows together to create quilt top. Trim edges to create a circle.
- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Bind as desired.
