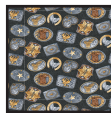

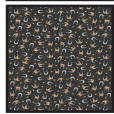

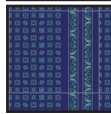

Fabric Requirements

Fabric A	Leather Work - Sienna	1.6m
Fabric B	Paisley Toss - Blue	0.5m
Fabric C	Paisley Toss - Red	0.6m
Fabric D	Rodeo Buckles - Black	0.6m
Fabric E	Bandana Double Border - Blue	0.7m
Fabric F	Bandana Double Border - Red	0.6m
Fabric G	Horseshoes - Black	0.7m
Fabric H	Large Scenic Panel - Sienna	1 Panel

Backing

Fabric I	Wild Horse Collage - Multi Sienna	4.9m

Binding

Fabric J	Horseshoes - Blue	0.6m

Please read instructions carefully before cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge unless otherwise noted.

From Fabric A cut:

(8) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 5" x 44" strips

(2) 5" x 72" strips

(8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub Cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 33" strips

Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 95" strips

From Fabric B cut:

(3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 5" x 45" strips

(2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 41" strips

From Fabric C cut:

(3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 5" x 52" strips

(3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 50" strips

From Fabric D cut:

(3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 5" x 56" strips

(3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 59" strips

From Fabric E cut:

(3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 5" x 60" strips

(3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 68" strips

From Fabric F cut:

(3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 5" x 64" strips

(4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 77" strips

From Fabric G cut:

(3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 5" x 68" strips

(4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and sub cut:

(2) 2 1/2" x 86" strips

From Fabric H cut:

(1) 23" x 44" Panel

Quilt Top Assembly - Seam Allowance: 1/4"

Begin by taking (1) H and sewing (1) A 5" x 44" strip to the top of (1) H, Sew remaining (1) A 5" x 44" strip to the bottom of (1) E.



Sew (1) A 2 1/2" x 33" to the side of AHA. Sew remaining (1) A 2 1/2" x 33" strip to the opposite side of AHA.



Continue on using the quilt layout, all 2 1/2" strips are columns, all 5" strips are rows.

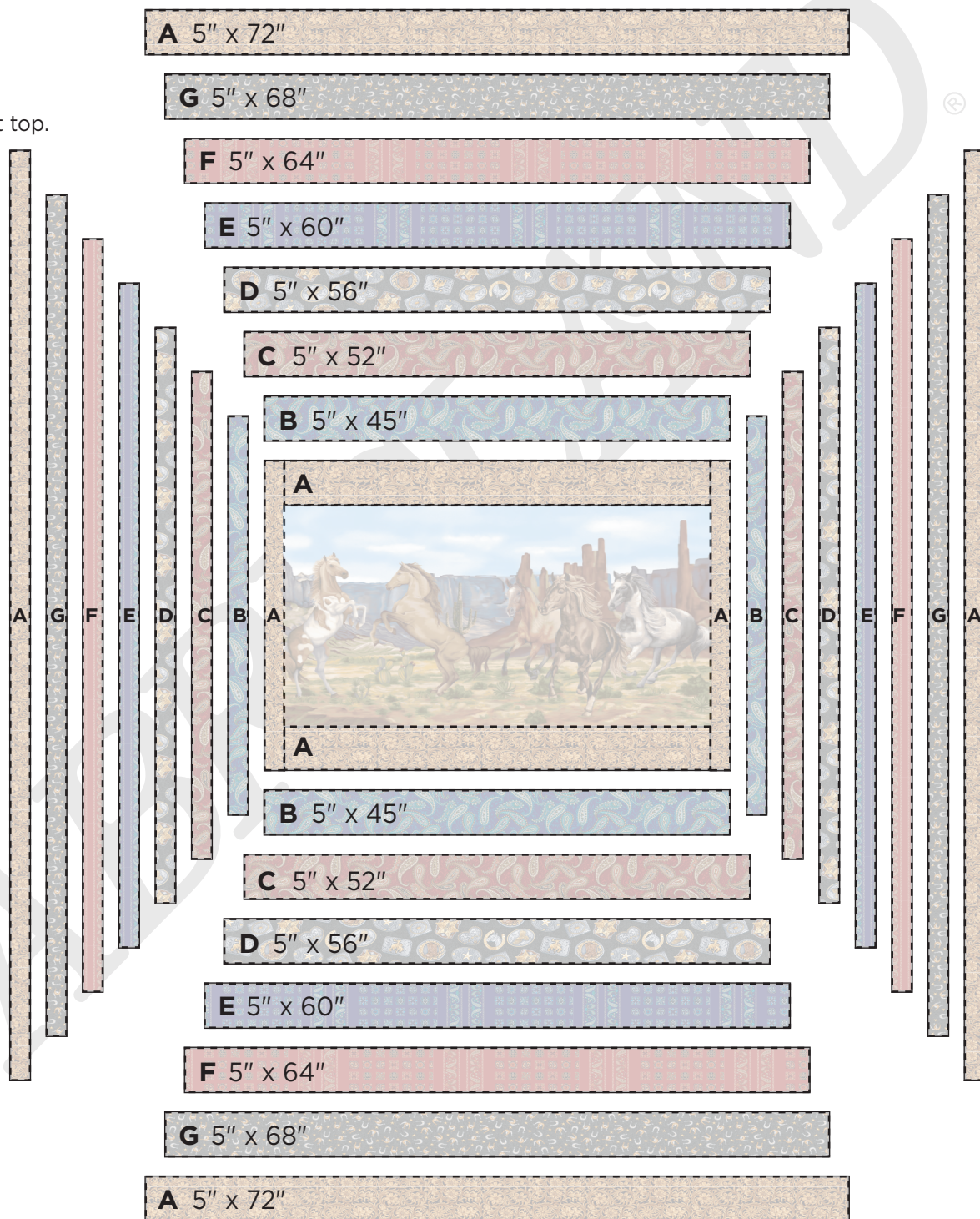

Quilt Top Assembly

*Follow Quilt Layout while assembling quilt top.

- Use Quilt Layout for fabric location.
- Sew rows and columns together to create quilt top.
- Layer and quilt as desired.
- Bind as desired.
