# **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge unless otherwise noted.

#### From Fabric A cut:

(4)  $14^{1/2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub cut:

(4) 14<sup>1/2</sup>" x 33" rectangles - Sew rectangles together end to end to make: (2)  $14^{1/2}$ " x  $65^{1/2}$ " strips (2)  $13^{1/2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub cut:

(12) 13<sup>1/2</sup>" x 7" rectangles

(4) 7" x WOF strips. Sub cut:

(4) 7" x 33" rectangles - Sew rectangles

together end to end to make: (2) 7" x  $65^{1/2}$ "strips

(1) 7<sup>5/8</sup>" x WOF strip. Sub cut:

(5)  $7^{5/8}$ " x  $7^{5/8}$ " squares

#### From Fabric B & D cut:

(1)  $7^{5/8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub cut:

(5)  $7^{5/8}$ " x  $7^{5/8}$ " squares

#### From Fabric E cut:

(1)  $7^{5/8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub cut:

(4) 7<sup>5/8</sup>" x 7<sup>5/8</sup>" squares

#### From Fabric C & F cut:

(2) 7<sup>5/8</sup>" x WOF strip. Sub cut: (6)  $7^{5/8}$ " x  $7^{5/8}$ " squares

#### From Fabric G cut:

(2) 7<sup>5/8</sup>" x WOF strip. Sub cut: (7) 7<sup>5/8</sup>" x 7<sup>5/8</sup>" squares

# Half Square Triangles - Seam Allowance: 1/4"

1 Place (1) A 7<sup>5/8</sup>", right sides together with

(1) **C** 7<sup>5/8</sup>""



2 Sew 2 channels down the middle



3 Cut down middle and press open Trim to 7" x 7"



Repeat steps 1-3, referring to Figures 1-13 for fabric identification until you have made:





Fig 13: F/G Make (2)

Referring to Block 1-9 for fabric identification, sew your half square triangles together until you have made:






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
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# Tutti Frutti Quilt
